Further Australian Exploration Work in August 2010

Ord River Resources Limited (ASX: ORD) is pleased to announce that ORD's Exploration Manager Robert Meade is leading a team to carry out exploration work in Copper Flats and Suplejack starting on 1 August 2010. Robert will spend 15 days out in the field.

Copper Flats

From 1 to 8 August Robert will travel to Copper Flats in WA to conduct detailed geological mapping of a third highly prospective area where greater than 1% copper mineralization has been located in reconnaissance rock chip sampling. Detailed geological mapping of Areas 1 and 2 has been completed by Mr. Rob Harley of Rangott Exploration during the June-July 2010 period.

Mineral exploration activities within the Copper Flats Project is designed to target copper-silver mineralization akin to the Michigan Model, U.S.A. Mineralization found within the Copper Flats Project area, consists of stratabound layers of chalcopyrite and chalcocite in the Nelson Shale, and stratabound replacements of chalcocite with lesser pyrite and chalcopyrite and secondary malachite at the base of the Headleys Limestone and at the top of the Antrim Plateau Volcanics. Vein style mineralization is also present in the contact zone and below the contact between the Headleys Limestone and the Antrim Plateau Volcanics, as well as disseminated veinlets in possibly stratabound zones within the upper parts of the Antrim Plateau Volcanics.

The detailed geological mapping work will better define the relationship between mineralization and host lithology and structure, and thus assist with definition of prospective areas warranting ground geophysical surveying. Interpretation of all mapping data will be completed in August, prior to the determination of all ground geophysical surveys. ORD intends to undertake drilling of prioritized targets resulting from geological mapping and ground geophysical survey activities.

Suplejack

Subsequent to the completion of geological mapping at Copper Flats, Robert will travel to ORD's Suplejack Gold Project in the Tanami Region of Northern Territory. Rob will spend 6 days evaluating the geological setting at Tregony, PhD, Trucks, Maly's Knob, Boco, and Central Prospect areas, in an endeavour to significantly improve the understanding of the structural setting hosting anomalous gold mineralization. This work will form the basis for determination of an aggressive exploration program at Suplejack Gold Project dominated by

drilling. ORD will strive to fast-track preliminary exploration activities to facilitate the commencement of this drilling program in 2010 prior to the onset of the wet season.

Robert will return to Sydney on 15 August. We look forward to updating you further.
